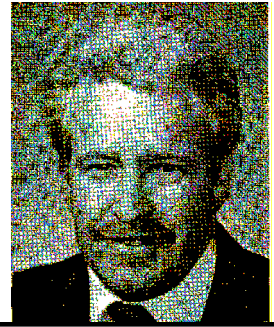


William R. Brightbill, FCSI

WILLIAM R. BRIGHTBILL is a lifelong resident of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. Born in 1947, he attended Harrisburg Area Community College for 1-1/2. years before beginning a 6 year tour of duty in the U.S. Army Reserves, He was honorably discharged in 1973 at the rank of Staff Sargent.

His career in the construction industry began in 1968 by employment with Ritter Bros., Inc., a well established general contracting firm located in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. His early duties with the company included support to the construction and estimating department, expediting, scheduling, coordinating material deliveries to project sites, and accumulating required information for project closeout. This early training gave him an opportunity to become well acquainted with all aspects of the contracting process as well as a chance to work with all of the players in the business.

Following his Chapter service, Bill continued on as an active participant in Region activities. Prior to his election as Director, he served in important financial positions as Chapter Treasurer, Region conference Treasurer, Region

Treasurer, Region Secretary, and for six years on the Institute Finance Committee, three as Committee Chair.

In 1988, he was elected a Director of the Institute representing the Middle Atlantic Region. During his last year on the Institute Board he served as a member of the Institute Ad Hoc Region Study Committee in the arduous task of advising the Institute Board on the issue of rights, privileges, responsibility and role of the Regions as entities in relation to the Institute. As a result of this action, a new section, "Organization of an Incorporated Region" was added to the CST Administrative References.

In addition to his many CSI activities at both the Chapter and Region level, he became closely involved with the Harrisburg Builders Exchange. The BX is a Harrisburg based association consisting of over 600 members made up of all elements of construction community.

In 1991, Bill purchased Ritter Bros., Inc. and now serves as their President and Chief Executive Officer.
